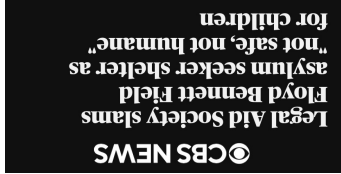
BECAUSE MIGRANT JUSTICE IS A REPRODUCTIVE JUSTICE ISSUE!

Sistersong defines Reproductive Justice as the human right to maintain personal bodily autonomy, have children, not have children, and parent the children we have in safe and sustainable communities.

A MESSAGE TO COPMAYOR ADAMS

Stop pitting New Yorkers against each other! While you continue to cut funding to our parks, libraries, schools, and public health, New Yorkers are suffering – but somehow there's always money for the NYPD. ALL neighbors deserve access to healthcare, affordable food and housing, education, and mental health support. All New Yorkers deserve safe abortion access and safe communities in which to raise their families.

Migrants trapped in NYC's dangerous and inhuman system face a lack of prenatal care, medical care, child care supplies, and menstrual products – not to mention food and shelter from the cold. Migrants, especially women and LGBTQ+ people, face sexual abuse in ICE detention facilities.



"It's an extremely isolated site. It has bathrooms that are outdoors and very difficult to access. And the sleeping areas are extremely tight with absolutely no storage space at all for clothing, personal belongings, formula, diapers, anything," Rudolph said. Advocates say it's not safe or sanitary for pregnant moms, children and asylum seekers with disabilities.

THERE CAN BE NO JUST ABORTION ACCESS WITHOUT ABUNDANCE AND CARE FOR ALL OF US – OTHERWISE, IT'S JUST EUGENICS!

Genocide Joe and CopMayor Adams may talk a big game about abortion access and reproductive rights, but there is no reproductive justice until we all have bodily autonomy, access to safe abortions, and safe communities in which to raise children if we choose to have them.

From NYC, to Palestine, to the Congo, to the Sudan.



Every week hundreds of migrants are forced to wait days in freezing temperatures for the promise of shelter that does not come. Eric Adams has destroyed the Right to Shelter, forcing newly arrived neighbors, including children and pregnant people, out on the street after 30 days to wait in line in the rigid cold to try and find housing. The tent shelters migrants are placed in are hazardous, inhumane, isolated, and prone to flooding. Often they are in inadequate locations without bedding or access to running water.

DANGEROUS CONDITIONS

In January 2024, a three-month old baby girl died in one such shelter in Queens.
